**MARKET SQUARE (CASTLETOWN)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) (NO 2)
ORDER 2010**

Coming into Operation: 31 August 2010

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

- 1 **Title**
This Order is the Market Square (Castletown) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) (No 2) Order 2010.
- 2 **Commencement**
This Order comes into operation at 4.30 pm on 31 August 2010.
- 3 **Temporary suspension of parking**
No person must cause any vehicle to be parked on both sides of Market Square, Castletown from its junction with Castle Street to the pedestrian areas of Malew Street and Arbory Street.
- 4 **Duration**
This Order is in force from 4.30 pm until 8.00 pm on 31 August 2010.

- (iii) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Infrastructure in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road;
- (b) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service;
- (c) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Infrastructure for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (d) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department of Infrastructure.

5 Duration

This Order is in force from 4.30 pm until 8.00 pm on 31 August 2010 or until the Vintage Motorcycle Club Display is completed, whichever is the earlier.
