



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**MARKET SQUARE (CASTLETOWN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2010**

Coming into Operation: 31 August 2010

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

- 1 Title**
This Order is the Market Square (Castletown) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2010.
- 2 Commencement**
This Order comes into operation at 4.30 pm on 31 August 2010.
- 3 Temporary closure of road to through traffic**
No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of Market Square, Castletown, from its junction with Castle Street to the pedestrian areas of Malew Street and Arbory Street.
- 4 Exemptions**
Article 3 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in article 3 or to—
 - (a) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations—
 - (i) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in article 3;
 - (ii) works in the road specified in article 3 authorised by statutory provisions; or

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily suspend the parking spaces on both sides of Market Square, Castletown from its junction with Castle Street to the pedestrian areas of Malew Street and Arbory Street.
