AB/098.18 Chairman's Update

AB/099.18 Approval of minutes from Ordinary Board Meeting

Miss Quine proposed that this be agreed and was seconded by Mr Horton with all in favour.

Information was received from Manx Auto Sport and the Isle of Man Youth tour respectively with regard proposed events on the Billown Circuit.

Members note such and were all in favour, however Mr McAleer felt that it was important that the goodwill of individuals living around the S100 course was not exhausted.
